

IMPORTANT!!!

Before your booking is finalized, we would like to receive a fully completed intake form and a copy of the vaccination stamps. Unfortunately, your cat/dog cannot be admitted to our Pension without a valid vaccination booklet with the most recent vaccinations received! We are not allowed to accept cats/dogs that are in poor condition, have contagious diseases, have not been socialized or are a danger to other animals and/or people.

Male cats.

Unneutered male cats can be admitted to our Pension up to the age of 6 months. Afterwards they will have to be neutered.

Vaccinations and precaution

To protect your cat/dog and the protection of the other cats/dogs, we impose the following conditions on a stay in our Pension:

FOR CATS:

Rabies, once in three years. End date may not expire during your stay in our Pension.

Cat flu and Cat distemper. (Combi vaccination) Mandatory in Hungary. Annually at least 2 weeks before the date of arrival in our Pension and the end date may not expire during the stay in our Pension.

If your cat has never been vaccinated or the last combi vaccination was more than 1 year ago, your cat must be vaccinated twice. There must be 3 weeks between the 1st and 2nd vaccination. The cat is welcome in our Pension 1 week after the 2nd vaccination.

It is advisable to inform the vet that the cat is going to a pension so that, if desired, a blood test for FIV/FelV can be taken.

FOR DOGS:

Rabies, mandatory annually in Hungary. End date must not expire during your stay in our pension, otherwise vaccinate again at least 3 weeks before your arrival date in our pension.

Cocktail vaccination (Weil's disease, Parvo, Distemper, Liver disease HCC) The cocktail vaccination must be done at least 2 weeks before the date of arrival in our Pension and the end date must not expire during the stay in our Pension.

If your dog has never been vaccinated or the last vaccination was more than 1 year ago, your dog must be vaccinated twice. There must be 3 weeks between the 1st and 2nd vaccination. The dog is welcome in our Pension 1 week after the 2nd vaccination.

Recommended (not required): Kennel cough. The kennel cough nasal vaccination works after 72 hours and may be a maximum of 1 year old.

It is advisable to inform the vet that the dog is going to a pension.

When your cat/dog comes to stay with us, it is important that it is free of fleas, worms and mites. We recommend that you deworm and deflea your cat/dog before a stay. If we still discover fleas, worms or other parasites in your cat/dog, we will have to treat it against them. The costs for this will be passed on to you.

If there are any matters relating to the health of your pet that are important, such as being in heat, we request that you inform us of this on the intake form. If you do not report this, it is at your own risk.

URALTOBET pension is small-scale and gives a lot of attention and the best possible care to your cat/dog. But given the method of care (cats can have contact with each other, just as dogs can have contact with each other), the risk of injury or contamination cannot be ruled out. The Pension accepts no liability for this, neither for direct nor for indirect damage.
